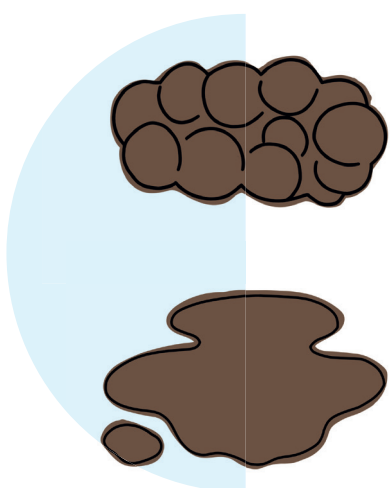


Are you worried about your poo?

Are you pooing **less than usual**?

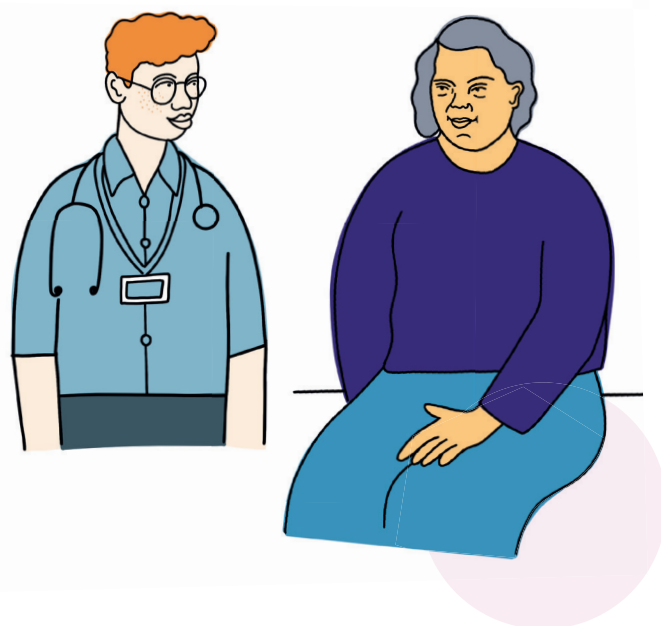
It could be constipation. Tell someone you trust.

They will arrange for you to **get the help you need.**



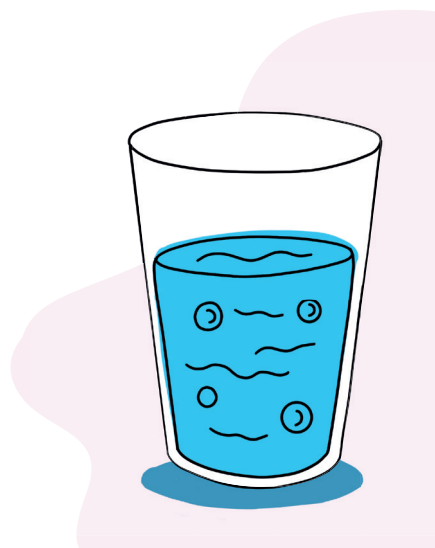
Things that can help
